NOTE: Q2 to Q5 to be done on a separate notebook (neatly covered).

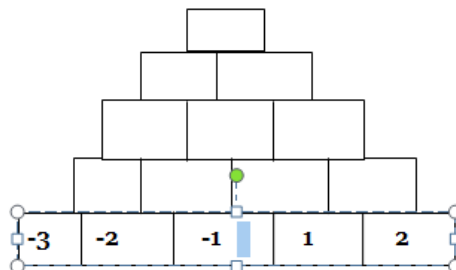
